Please check your old remote is 303Mhz by checking the sticker on the back of the casing

- Hold your old original remote in one hand and your new remote in the other.
- Hold the new remote next to the LED Light on the old remote as in the picture below. Push and hold the button you wish to code on the new remote, wait until it flashes twice. Remain holding the button down then push and hold the button you are coding from on the old remote. The new remote will flash twice to indicate it has learnt the code.
- Release both the buttons and check operation.
